



2026 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKET

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Purpose: To provide a one-time college scholarship to students in each region attending Morehouse College.

Award: Scholarships will be awarded to students by the Scholarship Committee of the Morehouse College Parents Council (MCPC). Scholarships will be awarded in the name of the Student and College for academic purposes only. Scholarship recipients will be notified by the MCPC Scholarship Committee and announced on the MCPC website in April 2026.

Eligibility: Eligibility is limited to applicants who meet all the following criteria:

1. Applicant must be a student at Morehouse College
2. Applicant must submit an Unofficial Transcript
3. Applicant must submit ALL completed materials by the deadline:
Sunday, March 1, 2026 at 11:59 pm (EST)
4. Incomplete packets **will NOT be accepted** and ALL reference letters must be included with packet.
5. Applications must be submitted to **mcpc.morehouse@gmail.com**.
6. Previous **Grand Prize** recipients are not eligible to apply; however **Honorable Mentions** are eligible.

The Application and Attachments: Please provide detailed answers to the application questions and submit all required attachments. Applications that are not completed will not be considered. All information received from applicants will be maintained in confidence.

Required materials for a complete application:

1. A completed application form
2. Two letters of Recommendation from internships, church leaders, employers, coaches from the past three years 2023-2026
3. A headshot
4. An essay 500 words (or more) addressing the topic below



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: Essays and recommendation letters must be typed, double-spaced, in 12-point Times New Roman or an equivalent, readable font, with numbered pages and one-inch margins.
